ICJ Administrative Policy State Council Enforcement	Dated: April 28, 2011 Revised: October 17, 2019	

I. Authority

Article IX of the Interstate Compact for Juveniles provides in relevant part that, “Each member state shall create a State Council for Interstate Juveniles Supervision.” This policy ensures compliance with the statute requirement that each member state or territory maintain a state council.

II. Applicability

This policy applies to signatory states to the Interstate Commission for Juveniles and Commissioners appointed to represent those states to the National Commission.

III. Policy

- A. By January 31 of each year, member states and territories shall submit the following information regarding their state council to the National Office:
 1. State council membership roster; and
 2. Meeting dates from previous year.
- B. Enforcement guidelines:
 1. If a member state or territory has not submitted the above information by March 1, the National Office will send a written reminder to the Commissioner.
 2. If a member state or territory has not submitted the above information by April 1, or has not established their state council, the Executive Director shall refer the matter to the Compliance Committee.
 3. Member states that join the Commission after January 1, 2011, shall be given an additional year, from their effective date into the Compact, to form their state council.
