## QUATERLY PROGRESS REPORT:

SUMMARY OF ADJUSTMENT IN THE HOME (including family relationships, compliance with home rules, and overall general attitude towards current living arrangement):

The minor has struggled with adapting to his new living environment. The minor's aunt has reported the minor is respectful in addressing her but disrespectful in his actions. The aunt advised continued issues with the minor not doing what was expected of him as he is using cannabis and doing poorly in school. The aunt reports within the home that the minor failed to obey curfew on two occasions where the minor did not return home for a few days and did not answer her calls when she attempted to contact him, this Officer was not immediately notified regarding this violation nor was the minor reported as a runaway. The minor reports he has little to no consequences in the home aside from being yelled at by his aunt. This Officer has witnessed this during visits, during these interactions this Officer has seen the minor completely shut down and become non-responsive as he is not allowed to talk or ask questions. The aunt has advised not wanting to be responsible for the minor any longer due to the issues reported above. The aunt was instructed multiple times to talk about this with the minor's mother and return the minor to Wisconsin. The minor's mother currently resides between Wisconsin and Illinois. The minor's mother advised plans to relocate to Illinois completely once she is able to secure employment and a residence locally. Mom has a new phone number 555-555-5555 Due to the mother residing between Wisconsin and Illinois with plans to relocate to Illinois, the family advised the minor will remain residing with his aunt until the minor's mother can establish herself locally.

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL AND/OR EMPLOYMENT PERFORMANCE (including any attendance, behavioral and/or disciplinary concerns):

The minor has not adapted well in school and failing all of his classes. The minor has had multiple disciplinary referrals for Disrupting the learning environment, leaving class without permission, horseplay, class tardiness, and failing to attend assigned discipline (after school detention/ in-school suspension). The minor routinely is truant to school and attendance records indicate multiple missed classes. The minor claims to be present in class and unsure why his attendance does not reflect that he is there. As a result, it was discussed with the minor and his family of a referral to an alternative school. The minor is apprehensive of attending an alternative school due to his past experiences in other alternative learning environments but after speaking with this Officer was open to touring the school before making a final decision. The minor is in the process of applying to YouthBuild as an alternative learning option. Youthbuild offers educational services in conjunction with trades training for their participants. The minor continues to maintain employment at a local Pizza Hut and works an average of 20 hours per week. The minor indicates he would like to find another job in which he would be provided more hours and a set schedule.

STATUS OF COURT-ORDERED CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISION (treatment/counseling, community service, etc.):

The minor has not payed his ordered fines or fees. The minor is required to complete substance abuse treatment and has been referred and started treatment in November. Minor is to completed drug testing. The November test was positive. Test results attached. The minor is expected to attend a session every other week and at minimum 15 session to complete this. The minor is expected to attend school as noted there are behavioral/truancy issues.

ACTION PLAN TO REMEDY ANY DELINQUENT COURT-ORDERED CONDITIONS (including length of time to complete task):

The minor has been referred to a local social service agency, youth Services Network - Youth Trauma Clinic, for counseling to address his substance abuse. The minor reports using to cope with PTSD symptoms from being shot. The minor began these services in late November. The minor is to apply to Youth Build for an alternative educational opportunity. Additionally, This Officer has discussed with the minor the possibility of implementation of administrative sanctions of community service, curfew, and/or in-home confinement should school concerns continue. This Officer plans to refer the minor to Redeploy Illinois should his non-compliance continue into the month of December. Within this program the minor will work with a local social service agency, Youth Services Network, to address his non-compliance through cognitive behavioral programming, life skills training, case management, counseling, and mentor ship. The minor's guardian will also be provided a Parent Engagement Specialist for support and assistance in overcoming any barriers that may arise. This Officer and the minor continue to work on his case plan. This Officer will continue to implement core correctional practices (ie. Behavior Chains, Cost-Benefit Analysis, Structured Skill Building, etc.) to engage the minor in his rehabilitative process.
