## Quarterly Progress Reports (QPRs)

- The 90-day timeframe re-starts in UNITY once the QPR is submitted to the sending state
- If the recommendation is to request discharge, the receiving state must provide a detailed, written justification that supports their recommendation.
- The Sending State has 60 days to respond to a request and either 1) Continue Supervision OR 2) Request Discharge.
- Check with your state's ICJ Office to learn about specific policies and procedures!

## TIME FRAME

QPRs must be completed by the Receiving State and forwarded to the Sending State at least every 90 days.
