The ICJ Rules

Rule 5-103: Reporting
Juvenile Non-
Compliance, Failed
Supervision and
Retaking

What should be included in a violation report?

- Date
- Description
- Status and Disposition (if any)
- Supporting Documentation
- Description of efforts made to redirect behavior (Therapeutic interventions and/or graduated sanctions or other corrective actions)
- Receiving State Recommendations

Violation Reports

Used to notify the sending state when a juvenile is out of compliance with their conditions of supervision (ICJ Form IX)
