

2022 UNITY DATA ASSESSMENT RESULTS REPORT



RECOMMENDATIONS

In 2022, the Compliance Committee conducted the first-ever UNITY National Data Assessment. Instead of a state-by-state approach to reviewing compliance with ICJ Rules, the Committee assessed 3 Compliance Standards to identify nationwide trends and areas of concern.

Assessment recommendations fell into three categories: Rules, Training, or UNITY-related. All recommendations below were approved by the Compliance Committee and Executive Committee in December 2022 and referred to appropriate ICJ committees.
